Focused on three key areas: **media systems**, **media representation**, and **media participation**
Combined **expert inputs** and facilitated **group discussions**, concluded by **voting resolutions**
31 resolutions, addressing the media's role in strengthening Czech democracy, were accepted
Resolutions include a focus on strengthening **media education** and **lifelong learning** opportunities, as well as enhancing **public engagement** and **awareness**, but also on **community media**, **pluralism**, **inclusivity**, and **better conditions for journalists**
